A poster presentation will be done in Manila during the International Nursing Conference (INC). Additional funding will be solicited to continue this project.
- Business and Asset Development chaired by Alice Andam, Auditor, in consult/advise with ED Annie Vista, are pursuing expanding solicitations, sponsorship and funding strategies to procure the Legacy HQ for all Fil-American RNs and future generations on a projected timeline.

- Finally, PNAAF 4th Collaborative Conference in 2017 co-sponsored with Bicol University of Nursing (BUCN) has drafted the MOU with the help of our Philippine collaborator Dr. Chris Sorongon, RN, MD. The "save the date" is posted in our website, date January 27-29, 2017, Legazpi City, Albay. The PNAAF team is composed of Luz Newell, PhDc, Araceli Antonio, Adviser and TedRay Llasos, past BOT.
